INTEGRATED YOUTH OUTREACH – BUSSI ISLAND

Project: Youth Truck – Future on the Wheels

Location: Bussi Island, Wakiso District

Dates: 27th – 30th April 2026

Background:

Bussi Island is a hard-to-reach fishing community on Lake Victoria with limited access to essential health and social services. Young people—who form the majority of the population—face challenges including high teenage pregnancy, early sexual activity, HIV risk, school dropout, and limited livelihood opportunities. Access to sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) services remains constrained due to geographical barriers and limited health infrastructure.

To address these gaps, Action 4 Health Uganda (A4HU) will conduct an integrated outreach using the Youth Truck model, combining health service delivery, education, and youth empowerment activities.

Objectives

Offer SRHR services - HIV testing, family planning, and STI screening, GBV Screening to young people, including young mothers and single parents aged 15-24.



Boost financial know-how and job skills among young people



Provide age-appropriate and accurate information on HIV prevention, family planning, menstrual health, and GBV.



Amplify youth voices through sports, debate, and edutainment



Methodology:

The outreach will adopt an integrated, community-based approach combining service delivery and edutainment.

Activities will include:

SRHR Sports Gala:

Engaging youth through sports while offering HIV testing, condom distribution, and health education.



Integrated Medical Camp:

Providing SRHR services including family planning, STI treatment, HIV testing, counselling, and referrals



School Debates & Role Plays:

Facilitating interactive SRHR learning sessions in schools and communities



On-site Financial Literacy Workshops:

Delivering practical training on budgeting, saving, and entrepreneurship through interactive sessions



All activities will be carried out with local health centers, peer educators, and community leaders, making sure everything is fun and suitable for young people.

Who We're Focusing On:

- Youth aged 10–30 years
- Young mothers and single parents
- Kids in school and those not in school
- Vulnerable groups like fishing communities and informal workers

What we hope to achieve

- Easier access for young people, including young mothers & single parents to SRHR information and services such as HIV/AIDS, STIs, STI & GBV screening
- Equip young people with better skills in money management and running businesses
- Making sure youth voices are heard loud and clear thru sports and edutainment

Budget & Partnership Opportunities

The outreach will require financial and in-kind support to facilitate service delivery, logistics, and community engagement activities.

We invite partners to contribute through:

- Funding specific activities (sports gala, medical camp, workshops)
- Providing medical supplies, SRHR commodities, or technical expertise
- Supporting community mobilization and outreach logistics
- Co-implementing and co-branding activities
